## 参考答案与解析

### 解析：

1. 'Ann am in Class Three' is incorrect. The correct form is 'Ann is in Class Three' because Ann is singular, so we use 'is'. Similarly, 'She are good at English' should be 'She is good at English'. 2. 'Are you Tom?' is the correct form, because 'are' is used with the subject 'you'. 'No, I am Tim' uses 'am' because the subject 'I' requires 'am'. 3. 'Where are Tony from?' should be 'Where is Tony from?' because the subject 'Tony' is singular, so we use 'is'. 'He is from the US' is correct because 'He' is singular and requires 'is'. 4. 'My pet cat is very cute' uses 'is' because 'pet cat' is singular. 'We like it very much' is the correct sentence. 5. 'Jack and I are both in Class 5, Grade 7' uses 'are' because 'Jack and I' is plural. 6. 'We are not in the same class' is correct because 'We' is plural and requires 'are'. 7. 'I am Chinese' is correct, as 'I' requires 'am'. 'I am from Qingdao' is also correct because 'I' uses 'am'. 8. 'Two apples are on the desk' uses 'are' because 'apples' is plural.
